Responsibilities and Duties

As part of the Flower Team, help guide flower through the post-harvest process, from drying to trim, cure, and packaging. Perform in-line quality control. Adhere to and help shape guidelines for efficient processing. Operate within a highly regulated environment, including detailed data logging and working in full view of cameras. Wear personal protective equipment when working directly with products and follow sterile process protocols. Maintain personal hygiene appropriate for a highly regulated and tested production environment.

Day to Day Activities

Work with a small team on a variety of tasks, depending on the workload scheduled. Tasks may include sitting and/or standing for long periods while focusing on detailed work. Track, record and log data for plant processing.
